



Gorilla Kleen Publishes Homeowner Guide Explaining How Gulf Coast Conditions Drive Exterior Cleaning Estimates

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Gorilla Kleen has published a homeowner guide that explains why exterior cleaning estimates vary from one property to the next, identifying buildup severity as the single most influential factor and connecting that severity directly to Gulf Coast environmental conditions.

The guide reports that homes across Sarasota and Manatee counties, including Lakewood Ranch, accumulate organic buildup faster and heavier than properties in drier regions. Humidity, salt air exposure, and year-round algae growth load exterior surfaces continuously, and heavier contamination requires more cleaning solution, longer dwell time, and more labor to address. According to the guide, this is the mechanism that most often separates one estimate from another.

Because of that mechanism, the guide notes that two homes of identical square footage can receive different estimates when their contamination levels differ. The guide outlines several cost variables that homeowners

can use to read an estimate, including square footage, surface type across driveways, siding, decks, and roofs, accessibility, and the presence of oxidation or oil staining. It frames these as market variables rather than fixed figures.

The guide describes pressure washing pricing in the regional market as ranging from roughly \$0.08 to \$0.50 per square foot, with full projects ranging from about \$75 to \$1,200 depending on the factors described. These ranges are presented as tools to help homeowners interpret estimates and are not presented as rates charged by any specific provider.

Roof surfaces receive particular attention in the guide. It explains that roofs often require soft washing, a low-pressure application of biocide solutions, rather than high-pressure cleaning. Soft washing can cost more upfront because it uses specific solutions applied carefully to avoid damaging roofing material, and the guide positions this as a protective method suited to the organic growth common in the region.

"The guide was created to help homeowners understand that the climate itself is a cost variable," said John McLoud, president of Gorilla Kleen. "McLoud noted that the same surface in this region carries more organic buildup than it would inland, and that buildup is what drives the solution, dwell time, and labor an estimate reflects."

McLoud added that surface type shapes the method as much as the price. "McLoud explained that a roof and a driveway are cleaned differently because they respond to different levels of pressure, and the guide walks through why soft washing is applied to more fragile materials while firmer surfaces can tolerate higher pressure," he said.

The guide is intended as consumer education, giving homeowners across the region a framework for understanding written estimates from any exterior cleaning provider.
