



Root Canal Treatment Kidbrooke General Dental Consultation Availability Announced at Kidbrooke Village Dentist (Smile 4 U)

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Kidbrooke Village Dentist (Smile 4 U) has announced the availability of consultation appointments for patients requiring root canal treatment. The update reflects the practice's provision of restorative dental care for individuals experiencing problems with infected or damaged tooth pulp. Appointments have been opened for those needing assessment for root canal procedures in the Kidbrooke area.

Root canal treatment is a dental procedure used to save a tooth that has become infected or badly damaged. The treatment involves removing the infected or inflamed pulp from inside the tooth, cleaning and disinfecting the root canals, then filling and sealing the space to prevent further infection.

According to the announcement, root canal treatment can prevent the need for tooth extraction and allows patients to keep their natural tooth. The pulp is the soft tissue inside the tooth that contains nerves, blood vessels, and connective tissue. When this becomes infected due to deep decay, repeated dental procedures

on the tooth, or a crack or chip, it can cause severe pain and lead to abscess formation if left untreated.

The practice noted that root canal treatment is often required when tooth decay reaches the inner pulp, when a tooth suffers trauma, or when infection develops. Symptoms that may indicate the need for root canal treatment include persistent toothache, prolonged sensitivity to hot or cold, discolouration of the tooth, swelling and tenderness in nearby gums, or a recurring pimple on the gums.

Dr Mori Shahid, Principal Dentist at Kidbrooke Village Dentist (Smile 4 U), commented on the significance of root canal treatment. "Many patients come to us believing that a root canal means losing the tooth, but in most cases the opposite is true. Preserving a natural tooth is almost always the preferred outcome, and root canal treatment remains one of the most effective ways to achieve that. Early assessment is key ? the sooner an infection is identified and treated, the better the chances of saving the tooth long term."

Kidbrooke Village Dentist (Smile 4 U) has confirmed that the consultation process begins with a thorough examination of the affected tooth. The dental team takes X-rays to assess the extent of infection and to view the shape of the root canals. Consultations include a discussion about what root canal treatment involves and what patients can expect during the procedure. The dental team explains that the treatment is typically carried out under local anaesthetic, so patients should not feel pain during the procedure.

Most root canal treatments can be completed in one or two appointments, depending on the complexity of the case. During the procedure, the dentist creates an opening in the tooth to access the pulp chamber, removes the infected or damaged pulp, cleans and shapes the root canals, then fills them with a rubber-like material. A temporary filling is placed to close the opening, and a permanent crown or filling is usually fitted at a subsequent appointment to protect the tooth.

The practice has indicated that following root canal treatment, the tooth may feel sensitive for a few days as the surrounding tissues heal. Patients receive advice on managing any discomfort and are informed about signs of complications that would require further attention.
